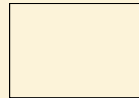

Dear Property Owner,

Pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2025-006 and Carmel Municipal Code (CMC) Section 15.55.100, this postcard serves as official notification from the City of Carmel-By-The-Sea Community Planning and Building Department regarding the assignment of a formal physical street address to your property.

The City has formally notified municipal and emergency response agencies to integrate the new addresses into public safety and delivery databases, including:

- Emergency Services (911 Dispatch, Fire Department, and City Police Department)
- United States Postal Service (USPS) Address Management System
- County of Monterey Assessor's Office and Registrar of Voters
- Local Service Providers (CalAm, PG&E, GreenWaste, Comcast, CAWD)

Owner Responsibilities:

- Ensure that physical address numbers are displayed on the property in accordance with CMC §15.55.100 and CA Fire Code §505.1. *Numbers must be a minimum of 4 inches in height, 1/2 inch width, must contrast with their background, and be clearly visible from the public right-of-way to facilitate rapid emergency response.*
- It is the responsibility of the property owner to inform tenants of new address.
- The City has made efforts to coordinate with major utility providers; however, you may still need to contact service providers to update your physical service address. You may also need to update your address with:
 - Government and Legal: DMV, voter registration, vehicle registration
 - Financial and Insurance: Banks, mortgage companies, insurance policies
 - Personal and Commercial: Alarm companies, medical providers, business records

Important:

No Authorization of Non-Conforming Units: *The assignment of an address number or unit identifier to a parcel does not bypass CMC regulations, automatically legalize unpermitted construction, or bring any non-compliant or unpermitted work on dwelling units into compliance with City zoning regulations.*

PLEASE NOTE:

P.O. Box mail delivery will continue to be your only USPS delivery method.

Your new address reflects a physical address number assignment only and does not change your USPS mailing address.
